

Oxurion Receives Transparency Notification from Negma Group

Leuven, BELGIUM, Boston, MA, US – December 6, 2022 – 07.00 PM CET [Oxurion NV](#) (Euronext Brussels: OXUR) a biopharmaceutical company developing next generation standard of care ophthalmic therapies, with clinical stage assets in vascular retinal disorders, today announced that, pursuant to Belgian Transparency legislation¹ it has received a transparency notification as follows:

Oxurion received transparency notification on December 2 from Negma Group Ltd. indicating that as of November 28, it held 65,537,782 shares of the then outstanding 269,264,838 shares, and therefore crossed above the 20% threshold by virtue of acquisition of voting securities. See Annex 1
